#### Grower

The Lyrarakis estate is a family vineyard and winery which has been producing high quality wines since 1966. Lyrarakis has devoted itself to the revival of indigenous, almost extinct, rare varieties such as Dafni, Plyto, Melissaki and others, vinifying wines that highlight their unique and distinctive character. Lyrarakis is located in the mountainous commune of Alagni (440 metres above sea-level), south of the city of Heraklion, in Crete. The soils are predominantly loam with either more sand or clay depending on the vineyard site. In charge of winemaking, is Myriam Ambuzer who has been vital in securing Lyrarakis a place in the elite wineries of Greece. Her philosophy emphasises precision, purity and supple texture of the fruit.

### **Vineyards**

Region: Alagni area, Central Crete. Soil: Loam. Aspect: North. Vines: Head trained, spur pruned. Altitude: 500m above sea level. Not irrigated Yield: 8.5 tn/ha.

#### **Vinification**

Harvested by hand. The grapes were destemmed without being crushed and then sub4ected to a 8-h skin contact at -°10MC and fermented at 16°1-MC, while -% of the must had skin contact fermentation. All of the wine went through malolactic fermentation.

### **Style**

Mid straw colour. Citrus and white fleshed fruit aromas are nicely combined with herbal green notes. The palate is Juicy and slightly creamy with a vibrant acidity and a long fresh finish.
